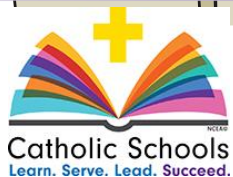
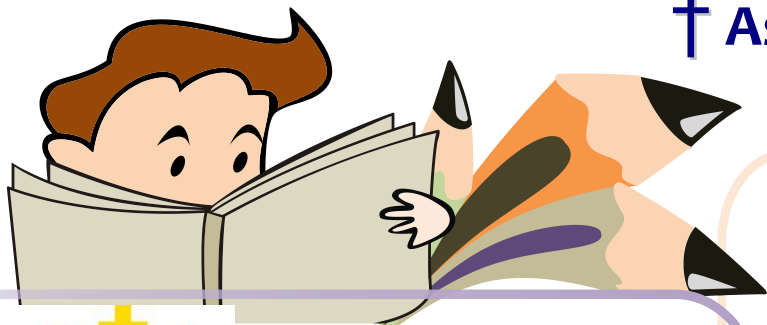

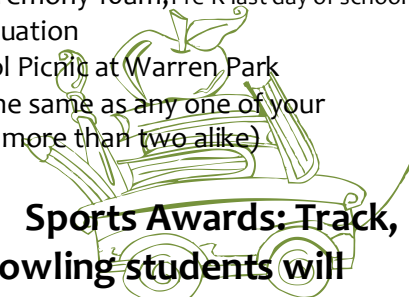
- Grades 7/8: 80's** (boys can wear sweat pants – “Rocky” look, girls fluorescent clothes, any 80's style clothes)
