7th grade Summer Reading List – Class of 2016

I. MUST READ: Number the Stars by Lois Lowry

As you read Number the Stars, be sure to keep notes on each character in the book. You will be assigned a character with a project outline upon returning to school. This project will be completed in a short period of time, which is why it is important to keep good notes.

II. You must also read a <u>non-fiction book</u> of your choice and select ONE of the two assignments below. Your reading material should be on your lexile level and the focus must be positive.

A. Prepare a PowerPoint presentation that includes the title, author, setting, character analysis, plot, and your personal opinion with supporting details. Make sure that your presentation is colorful and interesting. Include the book itself within your (no more than 6-8 minutes) presentation and be prepared to present on the first day of school.

OR

B. Prepare a video that includes the same information as list in number one above. You may give your report in an interview form with someone asking you questions about your book or, you may give your report as an "ACS Resident Book Reviewer". Your video (no more than 6-8 minutes) should be informative and entertaining. Make sure that you use a recording device that can be plugged into a computer. Include the book itself with in the presentation and <u>be</u> prepared to present on the first day of school.
