

6th Grade Reading List

Required: A total of three books must be read.

1. **Number the Stars by Lois Lowry (670L)** We will be discussing this book upon returning to school in book club. You will also have a test on this book.

2. CHOICE BOOK NON-FICTION: an account or representation of a subject as fact. This summer you are to read one book that is considered nonfiction. It may be about history, science, a hobby, autobiography, biography, or any other book that will be of interest to you. It **MUST** be nonfiction. It must be at least 100 pages in length.

A. Prepare a Google Slide presentation that includes the title, author, setting, character analysis, plot, and your personal opinion with supporting details. Make sure that your presentation is colorful and interesting. Include the book itself with in your (no more than 6 – 8 minutes) presentation and be prepared to present on the first day of school.

OR

B. Prepare a video that includes the same information as list in number one above. You may give your report in an interview form with someone asking you questions about your book or, you may give your report as an “ACS Resident Book Reviewer” Your video (no more than 6 – 8 minutes) should be informative and entertaining. Make sure that you use a recording device that can be plugged into a computer. Include the book itself with in the presentation and be prepared to present on the first day of school.

James and the Giant Peach by Roald Dahl (790 L)

Al Capone Does My Homework by Paul Kropp (610 L)

No Talking by Andrew Clements (820 L)

Brian’s Winter by Gary Paulsen (1140 L)
