First, every fifth grader must read **Restart by Gordon Korman**.

You will need your own copy of this book.

It will be reviewed within the first few days of school.

There will be a test on it after the review.

Second, choose a **non-fiction book** to read that is at least 100 pages long.

Pick a topic that interests you (like history, science, biographies, etc.).

Prepare a google slide presentation that includes the title, author, illustrator (if there is one), 5 facts of particular interest to you, and last, your opinion of the book supported with reasons.

This will be presented after the test on Restart.

Third, choose a book from the following list. It is really to your benefit to have your own copy but I will have a couple of copies of each book in class. I will assign you a project for this book within the first week of school that will be due a week later.
