- A. Prepare a Google slide presentation that includes the title, author, setting, character analysis, plot, and your personal opinion with supporting details. Make sure that your presentation is colorful and interesting. Include the book itself with your presentation (6 8 minutes) and be prepared to present on the first day of school.
- B. Prepare a video that includes the same information as listed in number one above. You may give your report in an interview form with someone asking you the questions about your book or, you may give your report as an ACS Resident Book Reviewer. Your video (no more than 6 8 minutes) should be informative and entertaining. Make sure that you use a recording device that can be plugged into a computer. Include the book itself and be prepared to present on the first day of school.
